




The man slowly tills the rich earth--

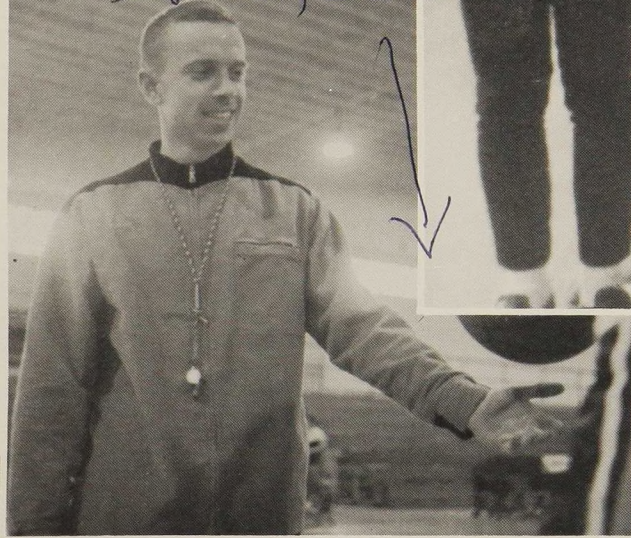
